

# BREAKFAST

Mornings can be really crazy! The alarm doesn't go off, the kids don't want to get up, there's no time to eat breakfast before the bus comes or they're just not ready to eat. If this sounds like your house, we have good news.

## **Breakfast is available at School!!**

Take advantage of this option at both Friess Lake and Richfield Schools, to ensure your child gets a nutritious start to their day.

Recent studies show a link between nutrition and learning. A nutritious breakfast helps students be more alert so they can actively participate in class. Breakfast has vitamins and nutrients for a strong and healthy body.

Breakfast at school is affordable too! A full breakfast with milk is just \$1.85. **Meal assistance is also available.**

Students participating in our Breakfast Program at Friess Lake School will be able to get off the bus and go into the cafe with plenty of time to eat before class starts.

5th - 8th grade students participating in our Breakfast Program at Richfield School will be able to get off the bus and go into the cafe with plenty of time to eat before class.

5th - 8th grade students will have the option of having Breakfast in their classroom during their break time for morning announcements or coming off their bus to eat their breakfast in the Cafeteria. This breakfast option needs to be pre-ordered. Please check the separate Breakfast in the Classroom Menu for Breakfast items being served. The cost of the classroom breakfast is \$1.85 including milk. This option is available starting the beginning of October and goes through the month of May.

Please consider taking advantage of this opportunity to start your child's day on the right foot. Your child will find breakfast at school not only provides a nutritious meal but also a relaxed atmosphere for socializing with friends before their school day begins.

## ONLINE PAYMENTS

Parents will be able to make payments online for their Food Service fees, school fees, co-curricular fees, etc. through the Skyward Family Access portal. The district has e-Funds for Schools in place for payment convenience. # COMPUTERIZED MEAL ACCOUNT SYSTEM

A food service account will be established for each family. This Meal Accounting System is a pre-pay system that must be maintained at a positive balance.

Each student will be assigned a five-digit identification number that will be punched into a keypad when used to make purchases. This five-digit number will stay with your child/children through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. When your child punches in his or her identification number their name appears on the food service screen assuring an accurate charge to your account.

Each time a purchase is made by a student, the amount of the purchase is deducted from the balance in their account. You can turn on a food service email alert through Skyward Family Access to be notified when your food service balance reaches \$10.00. An automated email will be sent out notifying you of your low balance.

**Payment is due at this time.** If your account reaches a negative balance, no further purchases will be allowed until your account is once again at a positive balance.

## DEPOSITS

Breakfast, lunch and milk money can be brought into school at anytime. **Only one check per family is needed** regardless of what school your child attends. **Charge cards are also accepted.**

When sending your payment to school please include the following information on the outside of your child's envelope:

CHILD'S FIRST AND LAST NAME  
TEACHER'S NAME (1st. hour teacher for middle school)

Checks should be made payable to the Holy Hill Area School District

## LATE TO SCHOOL/MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

If your child will be late to school and will be having hot lunch  
**A CALL TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE IS NEEDED BY 8:40am.**

### MEAL ASSISTANCE

Applications for meal assistance are accepted throughout the entire school year. A new application **must** be on file each year and benefits will not begin until the application has been processed. All families receive an application in their back to school packet. Applications can also be found on the District's website or they can be picked up in the office at either Friess Lake or Richfield Elementary School. Qualifying families will receive breakfast at no cost or at the reduced price of \$0.30 and lunch at no cost or the reduced price of \$0.40

**Only one full Breakfast and Lunch per day qualifies for meal assistance.  
Milk is not included in the meal assistance program.  
The cost of milk is \$0.30**

All families who believe they may qualify for meal assistance are encouraged to apply even if their child may not purchase Breakfast or Lunch. This helps the school qualify for additional educational programs and funds. Qualifying families may also have eligible school fees waived.

### HEALTHY SNACK PROCEDURE

The Richfield School District Staff encourages your child to have healthy snacks during the designated snack time at school. Please help your child to pack healthy snacks and lunches. **Please do not pack soda for your child.** Also please be sure to check with your child's Teacher when bringing special occasion treats to school. No outside food is to be brought to school for someone other than your child's lunch or breakfast unless authorized by the District Administrator.

### VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers are always needed to help serve lunch at both Friess Lake and Richfield Schools. If you are interested, please call either office for information. Friess Lake Elementary School at 628-1778 and Richfield Elementary School at 628-1032.
