**Dolphin Kids After School Program will  
be run by the YMCA starting in January, 2019**



Effective with the first school day in January, the Holy Hill Area School District's after school program will be run by the Kettle Moraine chapter of the YMCA. Some of our own Dolphin Kids staff were hired by the YMCA to make the transition smoother for our students. The [brochure](#) outlines the program, costs and how to register online. If your children are currently enrolled in the Dolphin Kids After School program that runs from after school to 6 p.m., please make sure to go online and register by Friday, December 21, 2018. This will make sure that you are all set to go for the transition to the YMCA program after the holiday break. If you haven't used the after school program and would like to start, you can register online at anytime as well. If your child is participating in the 4K afternoon program that runs until the end of the school day, nothing will change. That program is still being run "in house" by our district staff.

The pricing structure is very similar to what we have had for Dolphin Kids in the past plus a few nice additions!

- Dolphin Kids was \$12 per day or \$55 for all week with no snack provided.
- YMCA charges \$11 per day or \$55 for all week and a snack will now be provided.
- There will no longer be a discounted rate for picking up your child by 4pm since they must staff the program the same regardless of what time you pick your children up to ensure adequate overall coverage until 6 p.m.
- There will now be automatic weekly payment withdrawals made by YMCA instead of writing checks to the school.
- YMCA will provide all day coverage at Friess Lake Elementary on select non school days.
- Since this will now be a state licensed program, there will be opportunities to participate in the WI Shares Subsidy program for qualifying families as well as need based scholarships.
- 50% off of a family YMCA memberships for those who attend 5 days per week.
